Student Achievement: Provide a rigorous and accessible curriculum for all students and close the achievement gap.

- ❖ **ALL** subgroups will demonstrate an increase in proficiency levels as determined by multiple measures including API/AYP, with specific attention focused on-the identified subgroups.
- ❖ Increase by at least 5% the number of students who indicate that they experience meaningful participation at school as measured by the California Healthy Kids Survey.
- ❖ Implement strategies to increase student, staff, and community understanding of stress, both academic and social/emotional: “Challenge Success,” “Race to No Where,” and PUSD Homework Policy.

Safe Schools: Students in the Pleasanton Unified School District will be provided a safe environment in order to learn and to become productive and socially responsible citizens.

- ❖ Insure that Expulsion and Suspension outcomes are the most appropriate and least restrictive means of correcting and changing student behavior.
- ❖ Explore and clarify appropriate use of social media for communication and instructional purposes.
