

Dear Amador Valley Parents:

On October 22, 1986, the President signed into law the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) which requires that the District annually notify employees, building occupants or their legal guardians and outside vendors regarding AHERA related activities. This includes building inspections, reinspections, response actions and post-response action including periodic reinspections and surveillance activities that are planned or are in progress.

The original Inspection Report and Management Plan have been available for review in the Amador Valley Office and the District Office since the spring of 1989. As required by AHERA, the Three Year Reinspections have been completed since 1989 and are available. All reports have been included in the Management Plan located in the school and district offices. Information regarding any specific abatement activities are included in the Reinspection Report.
