Meeting came to order at 7:30pm

Guest Speaker

- CAP (Child Assault Presentation) is being given to all 1st, 3rd and 5th graders in the next few weeks. Areas that will be focused on include bullying, child abduction, and inappropriate touching. Details of the presentation were given and information sheets handed out.

- Auction: Patty needs volunteers including some committee heads.
- Holiday Gift Shop: Nancy has inventoried the items and set-up is Sunday. Kindergarten sales and preview will be on Monday, with additional selling time throughout the week. Volunteers are still needed to fill some open time slots.

Committee Updates

- Holiday Boutique: raised \$1200 and was successful.
- 5th Grade Outdoor Ed: 5th graders sold \$15,600 (gross) worth of cookie dough. One more push for sales is being considered at this time. Outdoor Ed will cost \$264 and payment is due by 1/16. There will be an informational meeting on 1/8 at 6pm.
