Meanings of Addition

You add when you **put together** groups.

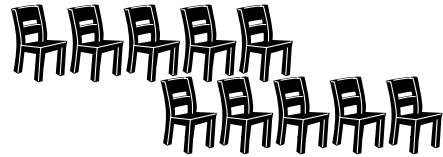
Eight white chairs are on one side.



Ten black chairs are on the other.

+

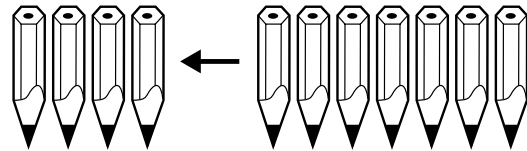
How many chairs are there in all?



$$\underline{8} + \underline{10} = \underline{18}$$

You also add when you **increase** the number in a group.

Four pencils are on the desk.



Ms. Cruz added 7 more.

How many pencils are there in all?

$$\underline{4} + \underline{7} = \underline{11}$$
