

DOGS PROHIBITED ON SCHOOL GROUNDS

Every school facility shall have a posting, at the appropriate entrances, informing the public that no dogs shall be allowed, whether leashed or unleashed, on school property. This regulation should be enforced by the school site principal upon direction from the Superintendent.

Dogs may be permitted on campus for special **one-time** activities; however, this must be done under the control of the school site principal. Owners must sign a form accepting full responsibility for the actions or injuries caused by the dog while on campus. If the dog is granted special permission to be on the school premises, the dog must be securely restrained by a leash not to exceed six (6) feet in length. The owner is responsible for keeping his/her dog under effective charge and control.

For the purposes of this regulation, any dog in a vehicle shall be deemed to be on the premises of the operator of the vehicle. The owner of the vehicle shall take proper safety precautions to make sure the dog is properly secured and restrained so as not to interfere with passersby.
