

SCHOOL DAY

The Superintendent shall present annually for Board consideration his/her recommendation for school day schedules.

When adequate classroom facilities are not available, double shifts may be scheduled, each consisting of at least a minimum day of attendance.

The minimum school day for kindergarten and for mentally retarded minors or classes prescribed in Education Code Section 56515 is 180 minutes inclusive of recesses.

The minimum day in grades one, two and three is 230 minutes.

The minimum day in grades one, two and three for educationally handicapped pupils is 200 minutes.

The minimum day in grades four through twelve is 240 minutes.

The minimum day in opportunity classes is 180 minutes.

The minimum day in continuation high school is 180 minutes or not less than 15 hours per week.

The minimum day in a regional occupational center is 180 minutes; in a regional occupational program 60 minutes.

The minimum day for special day and Saturday Vocational Training programs under federally approved plan is 180 minutes.

The minimum day for pupils enrolled in Work Experience Educational programs is 180 minutes.

The minimum day is exclusive of noon intermission and except in kindergarten, exclusive of recess.

Minimum days are used infrequently and generally affect all schools. However, there are times when one school or one level may have justification for a minimum day.

The school day will ordinarily provide more than the minimum number of minutes required by law.
