

DRILLS FOR EMERGENCY

Principals shall take every possible precaution for the safety of pupils and employees under their jurisdiction. In accordance with Policy 6114, each school shall maintain an up-to-date set of Emergency Services and District Plans for fire and disaster conditions; said plans are to be submitted to the District Superintendent for approval.

The District Superintendent, working through the division of educational services and school principals, shall establish rules and regulations for holding carefully planned drills concerning fire and disaster conditions to assure that all schools' Emergency Services and Disaster Plans are up to date and capable of accomplishment.
