

## **BYLAWS OF THE BOARD: REMUNERATION AND REIMBURSEMENT**

### **I. Remuneration**

No member of the community should be discouraged from seeking election to the Board of Trustees due to financial hardship that such service might entail. For this reason, the Board of Trustees hereby specifies that each member of the Board may receive monthly compensation up to the amount permitted by state law as compensation for services rendered. Each member of the Board may select an equal equivalent dollar amount from the District provided and approved health and welfare benefits in lieu of compensation, if this is permissible by law. This shall not prohibit any member of the Board from exercising his/her option to purchase for himself/herself the District provided and approved health and welfare benefits.

If a member does not attend all Board meetings during the month, he/she may receive only a percentage of the monthly compensation equal to the percentage of meetings attended, unless otherwise authorized by the Board in accordance with law. (EC 1090, 35120). Members may be paid for meetings missed when performing designated duties of the district at the time of the meeting. During any year members may also be paid for up to two meetings when the Board finds, by resolution, they were absent because of illness (EC 35120).

### **II. Reimbursement for Expenses**

Members of the Board of Trustees shall be reimbursed for all expenses incurred in attending any meetings or in making any trips on official business within the state for the school district. Out-of-state activities require authorization in advance by the Board.

Attendance at meetings related to education or school matters shall be encouraged for the values they have to the District and the professional growth of the board members. The Superintendent shall be notified of all such meetings to be attended by Board members. All necessary expenses as defined by the county, (including transportation, meals and registration fees), shall be paid for by the District.
